Recently, Cormac O'Sullivan and I have initiated a research program on hyperbolic Poincare series and hyperbolic Fourier coefficients. In this talk, I will discuss, work in progress, specializing our exact formula for Hyperbolic Fourier coefficients, to cusp forms on the full modular group.
